3. The District Court Final Judgment is a debt for property and services obtained by Mr. Sample by false pretenses, false representation and actual fraud.

4. The District Court Final Judgment is a debt for larceny by Mr. Sample, in that Mr. Sample wrongfully converted DIRECTV's property for his own commercial use and benefit without DIRECTV's consent.

5. The District Court Final Judgment is a debt for Mr. Sample's willful and malicious injury to DIRECTV and to DIRECTV's property.

6. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 523(a)(2), (4) and (6), the District Court Final Judgment is non-dischargeable.

Troy Don Sample, the Debtor and Defendant in the above-captioned case and adversary proceeding, hereby confesses to Judgment in favor of DIRECTV, Inc. ("DIRECTV"), and stipulates in this matter as follows:

1. On September 16, 2004, DIRECTV brought an action in United States District Court for the District of Utah (Case No. 2:04 CV 00872 BSJ) (the "**District Court Action**") against the Debtor and others for illegally intercepting, and assisting others in intercepting, DIRECTV's satellite programming in violation of 47 U.S.C. § 605, 18 U.S.C. §§ 2511, and Utah Code Ann. § 77-23a-4.

2. On April 20, 2005, the Honorable Bruce S. Jenkins entered a Final Judgment on DIRECTV's claims against the Debtor in the District Court Action in the amount of \$100,000.00, plus interest at the rate of 10% per annum and including attorney fees and costs incurred in collection of the Judgment. Such Final Judgment was based on Mr. Samples' stipulation that he violated 47 U.S.C. § 605, 18 U.S.C. §§ 2511, and Utah Code Ann. § 77-23a-4 as alleged in the District Court Action.

3. The Final Judgment in the District Court Action is a debt for property and services obtained by Mr. Sample by false pretenses, false representation and actual fraud.

4. The Final Judgment in the District Court Action is a debt for larceny by Mr. Sample, in that Mr. Sample wrongfully converted DIRECTV's property for his own commercial use and benefit without DIRECTV's consent.

5. The Final Judgment in the District Court Action is a debt for Mr. Sample's willful and malicious injury to DIRECTV and to DIRECTV's property.

6. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 523(a)(2), (4) and (6), the Final Judgment for \$100,000.00 plus interest thereon at 10% per annum and including attorney fees and costs incurred in collection thereof is a non-dischargeable debt.

7. Mr. Sample hereby stipulates and consents to entry of Judgment in this proceeding in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
